### **Details:**

- All Elementary Students must walk with a chaperone.
- Meet between 5:30PM & 6:00PM at Lincoln Middle School parking lot (Float location will be announced on October 31st at [Orchestraboosters.com](http://Orchestraboosters.com) and on our [Facebook](https://www.facebook.com/orchestraboosters) page)
- **Parade ends at the Fire Station where all students must be collected after the orchestra float pulled by the Scott Credit Union Hummer passes there.**
- Students walking with the float are asked to come dressed as a spirit by wearing black and white and decorating their faces like a spirit. Spirits, like a ghost, are people that are not living and still roam about. They are often seen as the person they were, but with a ghost like appearance.
- The booster club will have ghost balloons for the first 50 students to hold while they walk. Get creative and have fun!!
